

## TAMWORTH U3A AMBLING GROUP

Dear Amblers

Our next amble is on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July at 10.30am at Rosliston Forestry Centre, Burton Road, Rosliston, Swadlincote, DE12 8JX, a 154 acre site in The National Forest.

Bob Williams, leader of this amble, advises that the shortest route from Tamworth is via Wigginton (turn right for Wigginton very soon after entering A513, Comberford Road, Tamworth). Continue on to Harlaston, where you turn right for Haunton. Continue on that road to Clifton Campville. Turn left at the mini roundabout. Follow the signs for Burton through Lullington. Turn right at the T junction. After Lullington go through Little Liverpool into Coton in the Elms. Turn right, then keep left. At the next mini roundabout turn left into Rosliston. Go through Rosliston and stay on that road for about half a mile until you reach The Forestry Centre on the right.

The Forestry Centre is open 9am to 5pm. Wheelchair accessible. Parking: 2 hours £3. All day £4. Pay by card at one of the Pay and Display machines in the car park, or by coin payment machine adjacent to The Visitor Centre. After parking, follow the signs to The Visitor Centre, where you will also find The Education Centre containing The Hub Cafe, two buildings standing side by side, both with toilet facilities. Meet in front of The Hub Cafe, open from 10am. This amble is for one hour, through forestry and overlooking lakes. Walking boots advisable.

There are two options for lunch, The Hub Cafe, where we had lunch last year or The Bulls Head in Rosliston Village, 19 Burton Road, Rosliston, DE12 8JU, which you will have passed on the way in. Victorian free house, beamed ceilings, home made food, reasonable prices, draft ales. Parking. Lunches served 12 noon-2pm. The Bulls Head staff are happy to receive the number attending by 10.30am on the day, so just let me know on arrival at the amble if you would like to go.
